EXPLORING GREER STATION





Every region has its downtown core, and for the city of Greer, that's none other than Greer Station. Made memorable by its charming brick streets, Greer's downtown area is rich in boutique shops, awardwinning restaurants, and lively entertainment venues. With 40 of the area's buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Places, storied architecture can be admired on every street. Greer Station is the perfect blend of old and new, tastefully highlighting the region's rich history while bringing attention to the offerings that are new.







DRINK AND DINE

Greer Station is a foodie's dream. There's michelin-star restaurants, casual dining destinations, and tons of places that'll completely satisfy your sweet tooth. Whether you're in the mood for pub food, a good ol' pasta dish, the juiciest steak or fresh seafood, there's 24 mouth-watering options to choose from. And if you just want to catch up with friends over a drink, that's ok too — at Greer Station, neither coffee houses nor wine bars are in short supply.





SHOP

This historic downtown area will become your favorite place to shop, and for good reason. From quaint boutiques offering designer fashions to homeware, handmade artwork and vintage decor, these locally-owned shops are great for browsing or a routine shopping trip. Forget traveling to the grocery store to pick up alcohol, flowers and sweets — La Bouteille Wine & Beer, Urban Petals, Chocolate Dream Shop and SoBella Sweets have you covered when it comes to all those needs.



PLAY

One of the best parts about visiting Greer Station is being able to partake in the various things there are to do. Have a date night or a family outing planned but don't know what to do? Greer Station takes some of the guesswork out of the decision-making process for you. There's culinary classes you can purchase if you want to refine your cooking skills, galleries you can browse with a drink in hand, and live concerts to attend as well. And when you want to squeeze in a workout, there's not one but two fitness studios to use.





LIVE

Living near Greer Station isn't just great for dining, retail and entertainment — it's also filled with modern conveniences like spas, barber shops and salons; wellness centers like medical clinics, chiropractors and fitness studios; and other popular locations like churches, dry cleaners and banks. Stay overnight at the James House Inn — one of the National Register of Historic Places properties in the area which dates back to 1921 — or visit Greer City Park in the summer months, a 12-acre park, for outdoor movie nights.









Weekend Getaways PICTURE PERFECT ROAD TRIPS

There's no time like the present to pack up the car, get on the road and explore some of the best road trip destinations a few hours from home.





BREVARD, NC 50.8 miles; 1 hr 18 min

Home to some of the best local hiking, biking and waterfalls, Brevard is an outdoor adventurer's dream. Make a splash at Sliding Rock, dine at Square Root Restaurant and explore the Transylvania Farmers' Market for your fill of local treats. ASHEVILLE, NC 62 miles; 1hr 14 min

Asheville has quickly emerged as a road trip favorite, and it's not hard to see why. Perfectly situated in the Blue Ridge Mountains, the city is known for its picturesque waterfall hikes, creative arts and music scene, and incredible restaurants. Extend your visit and treat yourself to a one-of-a-kind overnight stay at Asheville Glamping.

CASHIERS, NC 75.4 miles; 1 hr 41 min

Surrounded by the mountain peaks of North Carolina some 4,000 sq.ft. above sea level, Cashiers is aptly known as the Aspen of the East. Many come to marvel at the natural beauty of this lush area, while others choose to stroll down Cashiers' postcard-perfect Main Street with an overnight stay at the historic Old Edwards Inn and Spa.



LAKE OCONEE, GA

A great place to visit if you're looking to be near water, lake Oconee is a marvelous network of waterways providing a true oasis outside the hustle and bustle of the city. Visitors can enjoy a tranquil day on the lake by boating, canoeing, kayaking, jet skiing or fishing. If you're looking for a weekend of fun and relaxation, treat yourself to a stay at the luxurious Ritz-Carlton Reynolds.



RONDA, NC 162.4 miles; 2 hr 37 min

Ronda is the ideal spot when you don't want to venture too far from home. Plan to stop for lunch on Lake Norman before heading up the I-77 to the home of Chianti in the Carolina's — Raffaldini Winery. Enjoy picturesque views of the Blue Ridge Mountains as you sip on Italian-style wines.

CHARLESTON, SC 216.8 miles; 3 hr 21 min

For those searching for some good 'ole Southern Charm, Charleston is the place to visit. Here you'll find something for everyone; beautiful beaches for relaxing and swimming, rich history to soak in at The Charleston Museum, antique stores, a world-class food scene, and the historic Charleston City Market to explore during your stay.

CHATTANOOGA, TN 263.1 miles; 4 hr 7 min

Chattanooga might not have initially been on your road trip bucket list, but once you visit, it'll keep you coming back from more. Located next to the Appalachian Mountains and with the majestic Tennessee River running right through town, visitors can take in the beauty of the city with a number of outdoor attractions including Rock City, Ruby Falls and Lookout Mountain.
